01 WHAT IS DORA

DORA is a national breast cancer screening programme that employs mammography screening for early detection of breast cancer. Every two years, all women in Slovenia in the 50 to 69 age range are invited to a screening test.

Organised breast cancer screening in Slovenia is carried out by the Institute of Oncology Ljubljana. The DORA programme takes place across Slovenia in public health institutions. The programme combines 20 digital mammography systems on which screening is performed.

The DORA programme mammography screening test, which women can access without referral and free of surcharge, allows for reliable and precise detection of malignant changes in the breast before they can be felt by hand.

Across Slovenia, the DORA programme provides women with quality treatment in accordance with European guidelines. The programme aims for a 25 to 30% reduction in breast cancer mortality in the target population.

03 DORATIMELINE


Between 2003–2007, preparations for a populationbased early breast cancer detection programme took place at the Institute of Oncology Ljubljana. The plan for centralised screening in Slovenia was confirmed by the Health Council in 2007.

The DORA programme was initially carried out at the Institute of Oncology Ljubljana and in mobile units in the wider Ljubljana region. Mammography screening was then expanded to include General Hospital Trbovlje, Health Centre Ljubljana, Health Centre Maribor, and University Medical Centre Maribor.

In 2015, programme partners prepared a new strategic plan for the 2015–2020 period, envisioning an expansion of the screening programme to a range of public health institutions, which had to meet more than 70 technical specifications. Today, the programme combines 20 mammography systems across Slovenia and invites up to 140,000 women in the 50 to 69 age range per year to take the screening test. 9






CHART 2 Cases of **breast cancer**, detected during screening
